- Learn to identify hawks with experienced hawk watchers.
- Make new friends interested in the outdoors and hawks.

Waggoner's Gap Accessibility:

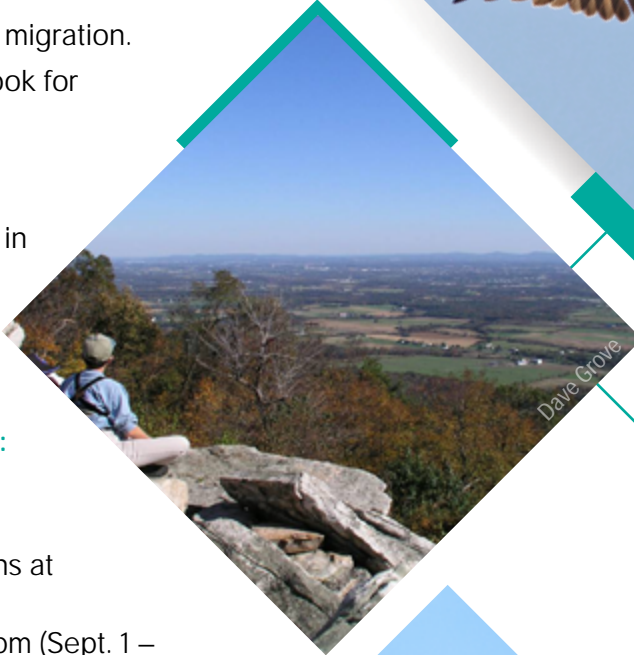
- Located on PA Rte 74 about 6 miles NW of Carlisle.
- Use detailed driving directions at www.waggap.com.
- Gate typically open 9 am - 5pm (Sept. 1 – Nov. 30) except in inclement weather.
- Take trail uphill from parking lot for ~200 yds. At split, left fork shorter, steeper; right fork less steep. Restrooms in lot.

Quick Info:

- Migration season Aug. 1 – Dec. 31, with daily volunteer/paid counters.
- Best winds NW (more birds) & S (closer).
- Watch hawks on both sides of ridge, often quite close.
- Lookout on angled rock pile on open ridge. Bring cushions to sit on & binoculars.

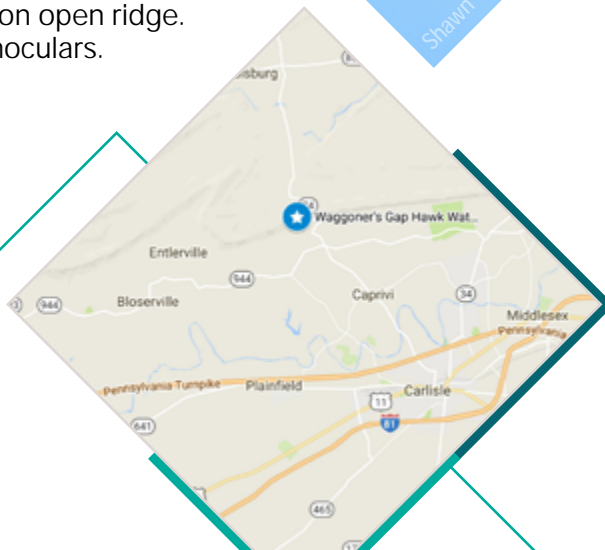
